Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 11 students have come back to school this year with a positive attitude and have settled quickly back into their GCSE studies. After close scrutiny of our most recent RAG assessment data, we have chosen to offer your child extra intervention sessions in key areas of the curriculum, to further support their learning this year.

These extra sessions will be subject specific, will take place after the normal school day and will finish promptly at 4pm.

We know this is a big commitment for both students and staff alike but, the decision has been given serious consideration and was taken to give your child as much assistance and support as possible as they approach their GCSEs. It is hoped that this intervention will give students further support with their revision, in order to achieve their target grades in their upcoming mocks in January.

Throughout your child's time in Year 11 there may be movement; it may be necessary to place them in other intervention sessions, or strategically chosen tutor groups, where the tutor is a specialist subject teacher, again to further support the students in their studies.
