<p><b>Component 1: Children’s Growth and Development</b> Learners will investigate the factors affecting growth and development of children from birth to five years old.</p> <p><b>Learning outcomes</b> <b>A</b> Understand the principles of growth and development <b>B</b> Understand how factors impact on children’s overall development</p> <p><b>Component 2: Learning Through Play</b> Learners will develop an understanding of how play activities can influence children’s learning between the ages of birth and five years old. They will consider the different types of play in which children engage, and how activities can support children’s learning and progress across the five areas of development.</p> <p><b>Learning outcomes</b> <b>A</b> Understand how children play <b>B</b> Understand how children’s learning can be supported through play</p>	<p><b>Component 3: Supporting Children to Play, Learn and Develop</b> Learners will investigate how a child learns and develops and how to adapt activities to support the inclusion of all children in play</p> <p><b>Assessment objectives</b> <b>AO1</b> Know about adaptations that may need to be made to activities for children in order to meet individual needs and support learning and development, promote inclusion and be aware of the role of the adult in managing safe environments <b>AO2</b> Demonstrate understanding of the types of adaptations that may need to be made to activities due to a child’s individual needs, and environmental risks and hazards that may impact children’s learning and development <b>AO3</b> Apply knowledge and understanding to adapt activities to meet children’s individual needs and promote inclusion <b>AO4</b> Making connections between areas of development, children’s individual needs and activities to ensure the adapted activities best support individual children to develop and to promote inclusion</p>
