Year 10	<p><i>An Inspector Calls Language Paper 1</i> Students start by analysing the structure and language of a range of creative texts and then move on to read J.B. Priestley's <i>An Inspector Calls</i> and explore the problems of Edwardian England's class system.</p>	<p><i>An Inspector Calls Language Paper 2</i> Students will finish examining <i>An Inspector Calls</i> and learning how to write critically about the play then explore writer's view-points and perspectives with both Victorian writers and modern non fiction texts.</p>	<p><i>Power and Conflict Poetry</i> Students will learn how to express themselves creatively, alongside studying the power and conflict poetry in the AQA anthology.</p>
Year 11	<p><i>A Christmas Carol Language Paper 1</i> Students start Y11 by reading and analysing Charles Dickens' <i>A Christmas Carol</i> as well revisiting how to critically examine fiction texts and write creatively.</p>	<p><i>Macbeth Language Paper 2</i> Students will study Shakespeare's tragedy <i>Macbeth</i> and revisit how to explore writer's view-points and perspectives.</p>	<p>Students will spend their final term revising all of the previous content ready for their GCSE examinations.</p>
